Limited to the first 16 teams who sign up and pay the entry fee of \$20 per player. Those who sign up in advance will receive a T-shirt. Deadline to sign up and pay entry fee to Donald McIntyre at PISD administration office will be 4 p.m. Friday, April 26, or until the draw is full. Remember, this is a charity tournament designed to raise money for the Princeton Lions Club and to have fun.

Format

Boards and bags will be supplied.

- 1) A random drawing will determine placement in bracket.
- 2) Arrive at 10 a.m. to meet and greet and warm up.
- 3) Bracket play will start at 10:30 a.m. Bracket play will be double elimination.
- 4) The first team to win 2 games out of 3 games will advance.

- 5) A match may not last longer than 30 minutes.
- 6) Games are played to 21 points. Winning team does not have to be exactly 21. The first team to have 21 or more points at the end of a round wins that round.
- 7) Cornhole Bag In-The-Count – A cornhole bag that is not in-the-hole but lands with any portion of the bag resting on the cornhole board is in-the-count (sometimes called on-the-board). A bag in-the-count has a value of 1 point. For a bag to be in-the-count, it must not touch the ground or any other portion of the court prior to coming to rest on the cornhole board. If a bag touches the ground before coming to rest on the cornhole board, it is a foul and must be removed from the cornhole board prior to the continuation of play
- 8) Cornhole Bag In-The-Hole – A cornhole bag in-the-hole (or hole-in) is a bag which is thrown through the hole in the cornhole board or otherwise comes to rest inside the cornhole board (knocked in by another player or an act of God). A cornhole bag in-the-hole has a value of 3 points.
- 9) A bag that comes to rest touching ground AND board does not count as a point.
- 10) Cornhole Bag Out-Of-The-Count – A cornhole bag which comes to rest anywhere except in-the-count or in-the-hole is out-of-the-count and has no scoring value. A bag which is declared to be a foul is considered to be out-of-the-count (no matter where it comes to rest) and must be removed from the cornhole surface prior to the continuation of play.
- 11) Cancellation Scoring: The approved method of scoring for the sport of cornhole is “cancellation” scoring - the points of one player cancel out the points of their opponent. Using this method, only one player/team can score in each frame.
 - a. For example: After all bags are thrown, player one has 8 points showing and player two has 3 points showing; $8 - 3 = 5$ so player one earns 5 points for his/her team. Player two earns zero points for his/her team.
- 12) Rock/Paper/Scissors will determine which team selects one of the options:
 - a. Choose the lane assignments; or,
 - b. Choose their opponent to pitch against (head-to-head)
 - c. If option #1 is selected, the coin toss winner chooses their lane and takes their positions in the Pitcher’s boxes, then the opposing team chooses their own Pitcher’s boxes to determine head-to-head match-ups.
 - d. If option #2 is selected, the coin toss loser chooses their lane and takes their positions in the pitcher’s boxes, then the coin toss winner will choose their own pitcher’s boxes to determine head-to-head match-ups.
- 13) Each team will stay in their designated lane for the entire game.
